




Ministry

Food Distribution: every week we are going out and feeding people who have lost their jobs or have not been able to work due to COVID-19

Discipleship Training School (DTS): 16 students from 4 countries are arriving September 18th to take part in DTS! They will be focusing on knowing God in a deeper more real way and then going out and making Him known in all the world.

Homes of Hope (HOH): we are building homes again! Even though we can't have teams from the states joining us yet, those of us who live locally are coming together and completing some of the houses that have already been fully funded!

Rehab Center: Something that has been on our hearts for a while now is to start doing weekly ministry at the men's rehab center in the area. This is the same rehab center that Hano was enrolled in as a teenager. We don't have permission to enter the facility yet but we are preparing short messages and bible studies to do with the men there once we are allowed in.

Ashley: Ashley, is in the hospital removing from 2nd and 3rd degree burns that are covering 45% of her body. She was caught in an explosion caused by a gas leak. She is being visited by a burn specialist from a hospital in Tijuana.
